Are you interested in helping us understand your housing situation and experiences?

The Positive Living, Positive Homes study is looking for adults living with HIV/AIDS in Kamloops to participate in research on housing for people living with HIV/AIDS in BC.

What is Involved?

- One interview in the summer/fall of 2015 (lasting 1.5 – 2 hours)
- A follow-up interview one year later (lasting 1 – 1.5 hours)
- \$25 for participation, plus childcare costs and travel reimbursement if needed, for each interview
- Questions will be about your housing history, your health, experiences accessing housing and shelter, and use of services in your community

Study Objective:

- To better understand the housing and health experiences of people living with HIV/AIDS
- To explore the successes and challenges of HIV and/or housing services and policies

Who is eligible?

- Adults living with HIV/AIDS in Kamloops
- Participants can be living in any type of situation, including homeless, stably housed or in supportive housing
